



CHÂTEAU HISTOIRE DE FRANCE

PUISSEGUIN SAINT-EMILION

Situated in the named-place Laborie, in the village of Puisseguin Saint Emilion, south faced parcel, planted exclusively with single grape : Merlot. This singleness expresses itself intensely fruity as a « fruit ball ».

VINEYARD

Area : Bordeaux, Puisseguin Saint Emilion, France

Surface : 0.5Ha

Soil : silty-clayey molasse

Blend : 100 % Merlot

Method of cultivation : carefully-controlled culture, Guyot single pruning, leaf thinning



WINE MAKING

Harvest : machine harvested

Fermentation : stainless steel vat

Wine ageing : 16 to 18 months in French oak barrels of two wines

TASTING

Robe : deep ruby colour

Nose : deep fresh fruit including red berries

Taste : velvety thick wine, silky tannins, red fruit

Cellar : 5 years
