

CHÂTEAU HISTOIRE DE FRANCE

CASTILLON - CÔTES DE BORDEAUX

Made on parcels of land at a place called Saint Philippe d'Aiguilhe, this wine combines minerality, fruitiness, roundness and smoothness.



VINEYARD

Area: Bordeaux, Castillon - Côtes de Bordeaux, France

Surface : 4Ha

Soil : mildly thick layers of limestone on hard limestone

Blend: 80 % Merlot, 20 % Cabernet Sauvignon

Method of cultivation: carefully-controlled culture, Guyot double pruning, leaf thinning

WINE MAKING

Harvest: machine harvested

Fermentation: stainless steel vat

Wine ageing: 16 to 18 months in French oak barrels of three wines

TASTING

Robe: rich purple

Nose: fruity and spicy

Taste: smooth with spices notes, slight minerality and silky tannins

Cellar: 5-8 years
